Consolidated traffic increases 11.7%

Panama, March 4, 2010 - Copa Holdings, S.A. (NYSE: CPA), and its Copa Airlines and Aero Republica operating subsidiaries, today released preliminary passenger traffic statistics for February 2010:

For the month of February 2010, Copa Holdings' system-wide passenger traffic (RPM) increased 11.7%, while capacity (ASM) increased 3.0%. System load factor for February 2010 was 80.8%, a 6.3 percentage point increase when compared to February 2009.

Copa Airlines passenger traffic (RPM) for February 2010 increased 11.7%, while capacity (ASM) increased 4.1%. This resulted in a load factor of 83.1%, a 5.6 percentage point increase when compared to February 2009.

Aero Republica passenger traffic (RPM) for February 2010 increased 11.4%, while capacity (ASM) decreased 2.8%. Load factor for the month reached 68.0%, an 8.7 percentage point increase when compared to February 2009.

Revenue passenger miles - represents the numbers of miles flown by revenue passengers
 Load factor - represents the percentage of aircraft seating capacity that is actually utilized





Copa Holdings, through its Copa Airlines and Aero Republica operating subsidiaries, is a leading Latin American provider of passenger and cargo services.
