Consolidated traffic increases 13.5%

For the month of March 2010, Copa Holdings' system-wide passenger traffic (RPM) increased 13.5%, while capacity (ASM) increased 3.2%. System load factor for March 2010 was 77.7%, a 7.0 percentage point increase when compared to March 2009.

Copa Airlines passenger traffic (RPM) for March 2010 increased 12.2%, while capacity (ASM) increased 3.4%. This resulted in a load factor of 79.8%, a 6.2 percentage point increase when compared to March 2009.

Aero Republica passenger traffic (RPM) for March 2010 increased 23.0%, while capacity (ASM) increased 2.4%. Load factor for the month reached 66.4%, an 11.1 percentage point increase when compared to March 2009.

Copa Holdings, through its Copa Airlines and Aero Republica operating subsidiaries, is a leading Latin American provider of passenger and cargo services. Copa Airlines currently offers approximately 152 daily scheduled flights to 45 destinations in 24 countries in North, Central and South America and the Caribbean. In addition, Copa Airlines provides passengers with access to flights to more than 120 other international destinations through code share agreements with Continental Airlines and other airlines. Aero Republica provides service to 12 cities in Colombia as well as international connectivity with Copa Airlines' Hub of the Americas through flights from Barranquilla, Bogota, Bucaramanga, Cali, Cartagena, Medellin and Pereira.
